Beginning June 3, 2019 and continuing through January 2020, our area will be participating in a pilot test for bulky item collection. During the pilot, we will need to schedule an appointment for bulky item collection. The current regular monthly collection will NOT occur!

Rycroft Terrace may schedule up to twenty (20) bulky waste items per collection appointment. Bulky items CANNOT be placed on any common areas anymore! Not in the parking garage, not by the elevator, You Need to Store it in Your Unit.

The City is giving out fines from \$250 up to \$2,500!

Site Manager Gwen Ishizu will schedule appointments for collection, and <u>she will let you know on</u> what day and time you are allowed to place Bulky items by the curb in front of dumpster area.

The building insurance, the Fire Department, as well as our governing documents make it very clear that "Nothing" shall be stored in these areas. Common areas need to be free and clear at all times.


No strollers, no beach stuff, no coolers, no gardening supply, no trash bags, no bicycles, no water bottles! Etc.
