Renovations / Alterations / Additional Utilities

Please keep in mind that ANY renovations and/or alterations to your unit needs to be first approved by the board of directors or you will be assessed fines up to \$500 plus legal costs.

Due to the age of our building and limited power sources/water drain lines, we are unable to accommodate any requests for installation of **dishwashers**, **washer/dryers**, or additional **refrigeration/freezer chests** in any of the units. This also includes **additional air conditioning units** <u>not</u> grandfathered in. Any replacements made to AC units must first be sent to the board to ensure it meets the required specifications.

Units discovered with appliances not board approved will need to remove those items immediately and owners may be fined for possession.

This also applies to units who have modified their bathrooms with walk-in showers without approval. Any such modifications require building and plumbing permits, these will need to be provided to the board for approval, even after the fact. Owners may also be fined for renovating without board approval.
