Enterphone issue with T-Mobile phones

Residents with T-Mobile cell phones have been having problems with the dial-9-feature on the telephone entry system since T-Mobile updated their system in 2016. The problem appears to be with the voice over LTE feature on Android and iPhones.

iPhone users should go to Settings > Cellular > Enable LTE > then select "Data only". Please contact Site Manager for assistance with Android phones as the settings vary on older to newer models.
