2. Festive Supper

~ Luke 22:7-9 "time to prepare"

~ something to celebrate

~ Isa 53:5 "by His stripes we are healed"

~ Rom 6:14 "no dominion"

### 3. Continuing Supper

~ Matt 26, Luke 22, Acts 1-2 (**refs**)

~ Acts 2:42 "continued in breaking of bread"

~ 1 Cor 11:24-26 "remember until.."

### 4. Convicting Supper 1 Cor 11:26-30 (**ref**)

~ "examine self", "sick, weak, sleep"

~ holy things of God

### 5. Prophetic Supper 1 Cor 11:26

~ "until He comes"

~ Rev 19:1-9 "marriage supper of the Lamb"
