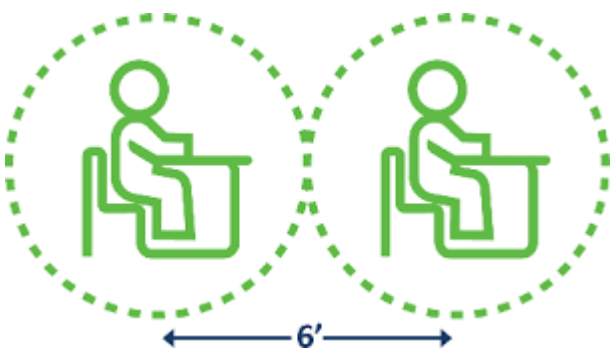


# St. Mary School COVID-19 Policy

- ♦ Masks are mandatory to be worn by all students, staff and visitors entering into the school or center. They are required while attending Mass on Wednesdays and Fridays as well.
- ♦ The school will supply ONE reusable mask to each student. You can wear one from home if you chose.

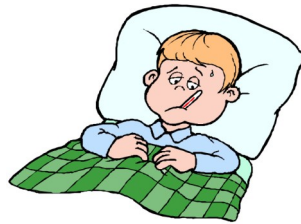


- ♦ All students will have their temperature checked before entering the building in the mornings. We have new drop off procedures-that info to come soon.
- ♦ Hand sanitizer-students will hand sanitize multiple times a day along with hand washing. The school will supply hand sanitizer but if you would like to send one that they keep in their desk you may do that.
- ♦ We will not have water fountains. All students will be required to bring a spill proof water bottle. The school will supply each student with ONE water bottle. We will have water refilling stations so students can refill as needed. We are asking that you only send water-no flavored sport drinks or anything sticky or that could stain the carpet.
- ♦ We will practice social distancing-students will sit 6 feet apart while in their desks and in the lunch room. This is why masks are mandatory in times that students can't be 6 feet apart.



- ◆ Be prepared for each day-Please send all necessary items with your child each morning-limited access in the building so remember to send everything with them (mask, backpack, planner, lunch, water bottle).
- ◆ Please do not send your child to school if they are sick, especially if they are running a fever or vomiting. Per our COVID-19 guidelines students must be fever free WITHOUT medication for 3 days before they can return to school. In order for us to keep everyone as healthy as possible please keep them home if they are sick.

- ◆ If anyone in your family tests positive for the Coronavirus you are to notify the school principal Mrs. Mead immediately.
  - ◆ If you travel to a HOT SPOT you must self quarantine for 14 days before coming to school.
