Kairos is a unique ministry and the 3½ day Weekend is simply the beginning of the commitment we ask all Kairos graduates to make. The Community Prayer begins, *“Jesus, come join us in our journey as we seek Your will for this community in this environment.”*

Kairos is a journey, not a destination. After the Weekend, Kairos Team Members are at the prison every Saturday of the year to aid the graduates in the growth of the Christian Community inside the prison. We refer to that as the 4th day (Continuing Ministry) and it is an honor and privilege to be with the women.

You have committed to the following:

- Attend all 4 Team Meetings (no less than 3) where we do more than train for the Weekend . We are the Body of Christ and it is essential that we know, love, serve and trust one another. This is the basis of Team formation.
- Complete your TDCJ Training as soon as possible.
- Make sure that your calendar is clear to attend the entire **Weekend** and the following Saturday for the **Instructional**, especially if you are on a family table.
- Become familiar with the Silver Manual and understand the Kairos Riverbanks.
- Write 42 love letters to the Participants.

Be part of the 4th day ministry as well.

- Attend **Prayer and Share** when you can. It is the heart of Kairos. Ask any veteran Kairos volunteer how they feel about this weekly event.
- Sign up to attend some of the yearly **Reunions (4)** and **Retreats (2)**. You will be blessed beyond measure!

As a Kairos Team Member, please commit to the following:

- Pray for the Weekend Leader, your fellow Team Members, the residents at Lockhart, those who will be Kairos Participants and their families, the Warden, Assistant Warden, the Chaplain, and the Correctional Officers.
- Be willing to accept any job, duty or responsibility assigned by the leader. It is all for the glory of God and the success of the ministry.
- Actively help in raising funds or donating to Kairos (to the best of your ability) to ensure that the Weekend materializes.
- Request and collect Agape that will bless the Kairos Participants and let them know they are loved.
- Invite a friend, family member, and your Pastor to attend the Closing Ceremony.
