### **SERIES DESCRIPTION**

This non-competitive program is designed as a combination show and clinic. The objectives are to introduce a rider to dressage showing or help a rider improve his/her show performance. The relaxed, non-competitive atmosphere of the show will also provide participants the opportunity to meet other riders and share experiences. Riders are not required to wear show attire. PLEASE NO DOGS.

### **SERIES FORMAT**

Riders are allotted one half hour. The format will be: (1) ride your test and be judged on your ride for a score; (2) be coached by the judge on how to improve your riding of the test; (3) ride the same test and be scored again.

- Any USEA 2018 Tests (BN through Training)
- WDAA Western Dressage Test Intro Level and above (2019 editions).

### **ENTRIES**

**Opening date is four weeks before event; Closing date is ten days before event.**

- *Members:* \$40 per session *Non-members:* \$45 per session Send entry to show secretary. Make checks payable to CNYD&CTA.
- *Secretary / Office Fee:* \$10 for each rider / horse combination
- Include a current Negative Coggins test or previous year (if tested within NYS), and a current rabies certificate with entry.
- Entries are limited. Preference given to CNYD&CTA members. If the show is oversubscribed a waiting list will be established.
- Entries processed in order received by the post-marked "opening date" up to the post-marked "closing date".
- Incomplete entries will not be processed until complete.
- Refunds: after the closing dates are only available with medical certificate (horse or rider) received within 7 days of the show date.

- Scores **will not** count towards CNYD&CTA Year End Awards, except for Rising Star Program.
- Please mark on the entry form if you are a Jr/YR participating in the Rising Star Program.

### **COVID-19 PROTOCOL: (Updated 1/20/21)**

- All paperwork and completed entries must be received by the closing date prior to the clinic. No exceptions.
