This jumping clinic is for those interested in hunter derbies, eventing, fox hunting, or others wanting to learn to jump in the open over a mixture of cross country and more traditional hunter/jumper style jumps. Footing is a mixture of grass with some use of a sand arena possible should weather necessitate a change. Participants will be grouped with those of similar skill and interest from trot-only (18" fences) up to heights of 3'.

STABLING:

In order to allow participants to attend the lecture, accommodations for your horse are available; however, Abbey Meadows is a small private facility with limited stabling. Please indicate whether your horse can be turned out in a small paddock, stabled in a portable stall, requires a box stall or can stand on the trailer.

COVID-19 PROTOCOL: (Updated 1/20/21)
