### **WHAT IS AN INFORMAL?**

An "Informal" is an educational, relaxed, and fun Dressage schooling show. Riders may show in polo shirts and are scored by an L Graduate judge.

### **WHY RIDE IN AN INFORMAL?**

- You may perform the same test more than once.
- The classes are not pinned for ribbons, so you may pick up your test as soon as it's scored.
- You can ride and pick up volunteer hours on the very same day!
- **It's STRESS-FREE and FUN!**

- USDF Introductory & USEF Training - 2nd Level (2019 tests)
- USEF Beginner Novice A&B, Novice A&B and Training A&B (2022 tests)
- Western Dressage- WDAA Intro-Level 2
- Leadline Class
- Include **level and test** in description box on CNYD&CTA Online Entry Form.

#### **FEES:**

*Members:* \$15 per test

*Non-members:* \$20 per test

*Leadline:* \$10, Secretary fee waived for Leadline

*Non-competing horses:* \$10-day fee (plus Secretary Fee)

*Secretary / Office Fee:* \$15 for each rider / horse combination entered

#### **ENTRIES:**

- All entries must be completed online. No entries will be accepted by mail.
- Any single horse and rider combination can ride in up to 4 classes
- Any single horse with multiple riders can do up to 5 classes

- For all horses include a Negative Coggins test date current or previous year (if tested within NYS), and proof of rabies and flu/rhino vaccinations with entry.
- Refunds: May be given minus the \$10 office fee, refunds after closing date are only available with medical certificate (horse or rider) received within 7 days of the show date.
- All horses (competing and non-competing) must wear assigned number at all times while on show grounds.
- Entries are limited. Preference given to CNYD&CTA members and completed entries. Entries are not considered complete if any of the above information is missing. If the show is oversubscribed a waiting list will be established.
- Entries processed in order received by the post-marked “opening date” up to the post-marked “closing date”.
- All payments to be made online via PayPal only.

### **SCORES:**

- Scores will count toward CNYD&CTA Year End Awards. See [cnydcta.org](http://cnydcta.org) for more information.

To participate, simply submit the online application and \$25 participation fee to USDF at least 30 days prior to the start of the competition. An online competition calendar will list participating competitions on the USDF website. Complete program rules are available on the USDF website.

### **ATTIRE:**

Clinic attire is requested (boots, breeches or jodhpurs, gloves, polo shirt); Show attire optional. ASTM/SEI approved helmet is required for all riders when mounted, including Western Dressage and non-competing riders.

### **ARENAS & FOOTING:**

Ring One: Outdoor Standard Sand Arena; In case of inclement weather, Intro and Training Level classes maybe be held in a small sand indoor arena (at discretion of management)

Warm-up: Outdoor stone dust arena

Lungeing: Permitted if not interfering with mounted riders

**STABLING:** No on-site stabling is available

USEF Dressage rules regarding bits, saddlery and equipment will be in effect for all classes. Unless otherwise stated, CNYD&CTA schooling show information will apply to this show.

### **COVID-19 PROTOCOL:** **(Updated 2/15/22)**
