*Please state level and test on entry form. Riders may enter Classes 10 and 11 multiple times as needed.

**Group class – please state division on entry form. Class 12 is to be judged on the rider's position and correct use of aids at all gaits. Will be pinned separately according to division and may be split if entries warrant.

Jr/YR(Junior/Young Rider), AA (Adult Amateur), Open – Classes will be held and pinned concurrently with open classes, BUT will be considered separately for CNYD&CTA year-end awards. You must state the division in which you will compete on the entry form. If not specified, Open will be assumed.

***Group class – Class 13 will be judged on the rider at the walk. Rider should be 8 years old or younger.

Awards: 6 ribbons per class. Champion and Reserve ribbons awarded in each of the following divisions: Introductory Level (Jr/ YR), Introductory Level (AA/ Open), Training Level (Jr/ YR), Training Level (AA/ Open), First Level, Second Level and Above. High Score Trophy will be awarded to the highest score of the day in any division Training Level or Above. A horse/ rider combination may win only one Champion or Reserve ribbon, in the highest level in which they compete. **This show is a qualifying show for CNYDCTA Year-End Awards.**

Non-compete: Will be allowed as space permits. Please submit entry form with fee indicating non-compete and proof of a Negative Coggins test for the current or previous year (if tested within NYS), and proof of rabies and flu/rhino vaccinations.

Entries:

Classes 1-11 \$20.00/ test
Class 12 \$10.00
Class 13 \$10.00 *Secretary Fee is waived for this class only*

Non-competing horses: \$10 day fee plus Secretary Fee

Secretary / Office Fee: \$10 for each horse / rider combination entered

- Include Negative Coggins (2022/2023) and proof of rabies and flu/rhino vaccinations with your entry.
- Send completed entries and payment to show secretary – must be received by closing date
- Make checks payable to: **Tanglewood Farm**
- Non-negotiable returned checks will be charged a \$20.00 fee
- Refunds will be allowed only with a written medical/ veterinary excuse, less a \$10.00 secretary fee

Times: The official schedule will be posted at Tanglewood on Thursday, August 3. Times will be emailed to all competitors who include a valid email address on their entry form. Times will also be posted on cnydcta.org

Arenas: Classes 1-3, 11 & 13 will be held in indoor sand arena (small arena). Classes 4-10 & 12 will be held in outdoor sand arena (standard arena). Warm-up: outdoor stone dust arena. (Indoor arena may be used for warm-up when not being used for show classes).

Scores:

- Results will be posted on cnydcta.org following the show.
- Scores earned may be submitted for Jr/YR, AA, and Open divisions for the CNYD&CTA Schooling Show Year End Awards, including Western Dressage. See cnydcta.org for more information.
- Members may submit their scores to the USDF 2023 Regional Schooling Show Awards Program. Please visit <https://www.usdf.org/awards/performance/regional-schooling.asp> for more information. To participate, simply submit the online application and \$25 participation fee to USDF at least 30 days prior to the start of the competition. An online competition calendar will list participating competitions on the USDF website. Complete program rules are available on the USDF website.

Attire:

- Boots, breeches or jodhpurs, gloves, polo/show shirts, show jackets requested
- All riders must wear ASTM/ SEI approved helmet (including Western & non-competing riders).
- USEF/USEA Dressage rules regarding bits, tack, and equipment will be in effect for all classes.

From Route 173: Turn onto Lafayette Road, farm is on the left.

From Route 20: Turn onto Lafayette Road off of Rt. 20 in Lafayette; farm is on the right.
