All competitors MUST read the COVID-19 protocol as outlined below.

WHAT IS AN INFORMAL?

An "Informal" is an educational, relaxed, and fun Dressage schooling show. Riders may show in polo shirts and are scored by an L Graduate (or higher) judge.

WHY RIDE IN AN INFORMAL?

- You may perform the same test more than once.
- The classes are not pinned for ribbons, so you may pick up your test as soon as it's scored.
- You can ride and pick up volunteer hours on the very same day!
- **It's STRESS-FREE and FUN!**

- USDF Introductory & USEF Training - 2nd Level (2023 tests)
- USEF Beginner Novice A&B, Novice A&B and Training A&B (2022 tests)
- Western Dressage- WDAA Intro-Level 2 (2022 tests)
- Leadline Class

FEES:

Members: \$20 per test

Non-members: \$25 per test

Leadline: \$15, Secretary fee waived for Leadline

Non-competing horses: \$15-day fee (plus Secretary Fee)

Secretary / Office Fee: \$15 for each rider / horse combination entered

ENTRIES:

- All entries must be completed online. No entries will be accepted by mail.
- Any single horse and rider combination can ride in up to 4 classes
- Any single horse with multiple riders can do up to 5 classes

- For all horses include a Negative Coggins test date current or previous year (if tested within NYS), and proof of rabies and flu/rhino vaccinations with entry.
- Refunds: May be given minus the \$10 office fee, refunds after closing date are only available with medical certificate (horse or rider) received within 7 days of the show date.
- All horses (competing and non-competing) must wear assigned number at all times while on show grounds.
- Entries are limited. Preference given to CNYD&CTA members and completed entries. Entries are not considered complete if any of the above information is missing. If the show is oversubscribed a waiting list will be established.
- Entries processed in order received by the post-marked “opening date” up to the post-marked “closing date”.
- All payments to be made online via PayPal only.
- **NO DOGS ALLOWED**

ATTIRE:

Clinic attire is requested (boots, breeches or jodhpurs, gloves, polo shirt); Show attire optional. ASTM/SEI approved helmet is required for all riders when mounted, including Western Dressage and non-competing riders.

ARENAS & FOOTING:

Ring One: Outdoor Standard Sand Arena; In case of inclement weather, Intro and Training Level classes maybe be held in a small sand indoor arena (at discretion of management)

Warm-up: Outdoor stone dust arena

Lungeing: Permitted if not interfering with mounted riders

STABLING: No on-site stabling is available

OTHER:

USEF Dressage rules regarding bits, saddlery and equipment will be in effect for all classes. Unless otherwise stated, CNYD&CTA schooling show information will apply to this show.
