The successful candidate must be **between the ages of 15 and 30**. They will assist with the management of the Hullett Provincial Wildlife Area and various projects of the FOH. **This position is funded under the Canada Summer Jobs program. Employee and FOH staff and volunteers must follow current provincial COVID safety guidelines.**

Duties include

- Collecting field data using GPS, maps, compass, taking field notes
- Leading a high school student as your assistant
- Recording and analyzing biological data
- Vehicle and equipment maintenance
- Habitat, trail, parking lot and grounds maintenance
- Ability to work in heavy mosquito infested areas
- Assisting Friends of Hullett Staff
- Interacting with partner organizations and the general public

Required Skills:

- Possess superb communication skills
- Native and introduced flora and fauna ID skills an asset
- **Must have a Valid Class G licence with clean driving record**
- Experience operating UTV, ATV, riding lawnmower, line trimmer and hand tools
- Ability to conduct field work in various terrains and inclement weather
