

# Hullett Marsh 2023 Water Levels

## Compared to 2022 levels

(Based on water DUC structure settings and summer precipitation in 2023)

- As always **preseason scouting trips** on foot or in a canoe/kayak will help you find **access routes** to pools based on current water levels
- **Successful** waterfowl hunters **scout** many times throughout the year to determine what areas **birds are using**
- Water level adjustments are governed by **Ducks Unlimited Canada (DUC)**
- **Major rain events will raise the water/dry periods will evaporate water**
- November and December will see levels rising

<b>Bluewing</b>	Average	Higher
<b>Butterball</b>	Average	Higher
<b>Mallard</b>	Average	Higher
<b>Whistler</b>	Average	Higher
<b>Pintail</b>	Average	Higher

### Zone B Major Pools:

- The **Woodie Pool** is average depth
- Repairs made to the **Greenwing Pool** dyke have resulted in great water levels with fresh new vegetative growth and new waterfowl habitat.
