Minutes from the previous Friends of Hullett Board of Directors meeting were reviewed and approved.

Treasurer's Report

- Chris Ambrose provided financials in advance of the March meeting for review.
 - o The BOD reviewed the financials and had no questions.

Marsh Report

1. Canada Summer Jobs Funding

Funding has been applied for and we are awaiting approval.

2. New Kubota Tractor

- Staff will have the local welding shop on Kinburn Line weld hooks on top of the loader bucket the same as our JD tractor
- Tractor forks would be a good option in the future
- ACTION Scott to review and provide quotes to purchase a set of forks.

3. Charity Dinner and Auction - Saturday April 22

- Visit to venue to drop off items and test POS and slide show on March 21
- · Richard Lobb has confirmed his attendance as auctioneer
- Program draft has been started in preparation for commercial printing
- Tax receipts and thank you letters need to be issued for donations
- BOD with auction items please bring them to Dashwood meeting on March 28

4. DUC HPWA Grasslands

- Mike Williams is the DUC coordinator for our 2-energy company habitat compensation projects have been contacted by staff
- FOH staff have sent pictures of heavy woody growth in sections of the Capstone Project
- Mike has asked FOH to quote performing the grassland habitat maintenance for the site
- Scott suggests a rate of \$225 per hour for the work to make it worthwhile for FOH
- Approximately three acres can be cut per hour with a fuel consumption rate of 12 to 15 litres per hour
- BOD need to decide FOH should quote this work...discussions with DUC regarding rates are posted below from the spring of 2019
- ACTION Scott to quote the business at \$200 per hour for FOH to proceed with this proposal.

5. Beaver Issues

- Mallard Pool and Pintail Pool drainage from private lands are plugged up with notice from landowner/farmer
- ACTION DUC have been notified and will be responding with excavators in April

7. Forestry Planning

- Ben has been setting up site visits for future assessment and planning
- Mat Shetler has provided a report to the BOD
 - o In summary through various consultants there is a need and priority to remove buckthorn.
 - o ACTION Steve to call the "Rough Groused Society" to attain advice and consulting for key habitat plantings
 - o Ausable Bayfield Conservation Authority (lan Jean) has agreed to a site visit, review and provide recommendations.
 - o The BOD agreed to wait on spending funds until further information has been provided to make future decisions.
