- Painting and trail maintenance
- Vehicle and equipment maintenance
- Habitat, forestry, parking lot and grounds maintenance
- Ability to work in heavy mosquito infested areas
- Assisting Friends of Hullett Staff
- Interacting with partner organizations and the general public

## Required Skills:

- Experience operating a mid-size tractor an asset
- **Must have a Valid Class G2 or G licence with clean driving record**
- Experience operating UTV, ATV, riding lawnmower, line trimmer and hand tools
