Marsh Report

- Ag Field Access Improvements
 - McCann/Merners completed the one access improvement just north of the Sugar Bush.
 - Cost was \$6748.66 plus HST
 - Cost was \$805 over quote above the allowed 132 tonne of recycled concrete
- SLED Forestry Education Funding
 - o There were approximately 25 people in attendance including FOH and OWA staff Subway lunch to be provided
 - Subway lunch was provided by FOH using SLED funding money
 - Next tour is slated for sometime around mid-October
 - o Presentation of drone presentation/demo of FRI mapping
- 2025 Spring Dinner and Auction
 - o An estimate of 200 to 250 staff hours goes into this event each year
- 2024 Pheasant Challenge
 - o Ticket sales are quite slow, still slow following August email push
- Accessible Hunting Blind # 1 Rebuild

- Phragmites Update
 - o The first scheduled spray dates are Aug 21 and 22 (ZONE B)
 - The second round of spraying has been requested the week of Aug 26 (ZONE A)
 - Scott cut trails to areas with phramites
- BuckThorn
 - More buckthorn being observed throughout marsh
 - Management plan should be considered
 - Buckthorn spray plots were checked week of August 12
 - Working on smaller trees, larger trees not dead, but not healthy either.
- BOD Photo Update for Website
 - Emily has requested new photos for the website as it is very dated
- Website, Newsletter & User Guide, Fall Newsletter
 - o Bulk of Newsletter is complete, Duck Opener is Sept 28, Pheasant opener Sept 25
