“Every Child Deserves a Birthday” was the theme of Banquet 2018. Father Torres from New York was our guest speaker this year. He added much humor to the night as he shared with us stories of his life. He also told some serious stories that showed how God moves and works in lives. He led us in singing “Happy Birthday” to the over 800 babies that now celebrate birthdays due to their mothers choosing life after visiting MyLife Medical Center.

One of his more serious stories about how God works was when he told us of his sidewalk counseling in front of an abortion clinic and then later learning that his niece was on her

way to have an abortion, saw him, and changed her mind about the abortion. (He knew nothing of this until much later—when a precious baby boy was already born.) God is so good!

He left us excited about what God has done and the work He continues to do, even in places where there seems to be little hope.

We enjoyed our evening with Fr Torres so much. We have had many banquet speakers in our history and I believe he ranks at the top!

Donations are still coming in following the banquet, but the total is well over \$55,000 so far! We also added several new monthly donors! Financially, the best banquet to date.

Susan keeps us aware of current pro life issues and is especially passionate about the current laws affecting life & family.


Susan has three sons and one granddaughter with another one coming in early June. She is very excited about her new grandchild and can't wait to meet her!
