

Dear Calvary Lutheran Church Congregation:

It's been a while since you have heard from the Call Committee and our work. We have been presented with 5 resumes from prospective candidates and we have held interviews with two candidates.

Our very first candidate withdrew from consideration prior to his interview date. We think he decided to remain in his present call due to family considerations.

Our second set of candidates was a husband-and-wife couple serving separate congregations. We interviewed them and after analysis of those interviews, we extended an invitation to them to visit us in Willmar, see our church and community and conduct a second interview. They deliberated for approximately two weeks and eventually advised us they were also withdrawing from consideration of our positions at Calvary. I say positions because of their qualifications and experiences, we as a call committee sought and received permission from the Church Council to look at calling this couple to fill both our Lead Pastor and Associate Pastor positions. Unfortunately, they also had family situations that affected their decision to remove themselves from consideration.

We then received another submission of resumes from a couple located on the west coast. After review of their resumes, we decided not to move forward with an interview.

Since then, no one has submitted their resumes to us for consideration.

As stated, many times, we are focusing on obtaining the best possible fit for Calvary and its Lead Pastor. We are using whatever acceptable means of seeking candidates for our position of Lead Pastor. We ask for your continued prayers and support in our Call process. We continue to work with and appreciate the support afforded us by Bishop Dee Pederson in this process, along with other Synod staff. Once again, we solicit any names you might have for us to consider.


Hello Friends and Happy June!




Library News
