

FREE RECTANGLE TABLES FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 29



Don't forget your change! The money collected from Noisy Offering will go to God's Global Barnyard.



NTY FRIDAY, OCTOBER 13 12:00 NOON

Do you know or have you ever talked to a Certified Hypnotist Therapist? Jessica Hanson, a CHT, will be our speaker for NTY on October 13. Jessica is co-author of the International Ass'n. Counselor's Therapists (IACT) trainers manual, owner of a state licensed hypnosis school, author of 4 books on hypnosis related topics, and creator of the Totally Unlimited Renewal Truly Living Excellence (TURTLE) Trance-Formation Process. She is Roy Hunter's chosen protégé-helping to preserve and make available Hunter's contributions to hypnosis. Jessica's love of turtles is contagious! Her passion is helping people trance-form with hypnosis.

What is hypnosis? At it's core, hypnosis is focused attention. Prayer is the original hypnosis. She likes to say: "Hypnosis is the life skill you were born with and taught to be afraid of." Jessica is often described as an "old-soul" because of her many experiences. She learned hypnosis at the age of 13 and has used it to recover from depression, near death experience, grief, and much more.
