Genesis 3:19b "you are dust, and to dust you shall return."

This is what we hear every Ash Wednesday worship service as we receive ashes to remember and recognize our humanity and our mortality. The imposition of ashes in a worship service is not in the Bible per say but neither is Christmas worship, but it is an important worship service to remember that we are not Gods. It is a reminder for us that it is God who provides us with grace and faith and God gives grace freely because of God's never-failing love for us.

As we remember our mortality, we can also remember the eternal life given to us into the Kingdom of God. Ash Wednesday has always been an antinomy for me, as we are remembering our mortality, and it is the beginning of the Lent season of worship as we prepare and wait for the crucifixion of our Lord, yet we know how the story ends. Jesus returns from the tomb in his resurrection and ascension to the Father and promises us a resurrection like his. It is good that we remember our mortality because it reminds us that we are not God and it grounds us a humble faith.

Ash Wednesday has fallen on Valentines Day 3 times in the last one hundred years and falls on Valentines Day this year and will again 2029. It is a rare occasion for Ash Wednesday and Valentines to share days and it recalls, can those two holidays reconcile? I give it a resounding yes! So, I invite you to our Ash Wednesday and Valentine celebration February 14th, 2024, and hear how those two holidays actually go together very well. Pastor Dwaine Sutherland

CALL COMMITTEE UPDATE

The Call Committee met on Tuesday evening, January 31, 2024. Agenda items included the following: Finalized the MSP for Associate Pastor position. Final amendments will be made on Wednesday and Wayne will upload the MSP to the Synod office for their review. Once they have reviewed it and approved, it will be published on the Synod site. We reviewed the job description of the Associate Pastor position.

We discussed the current make-up of the Call Committee. With only one student member at this time, the Call Committee felt it would be appropriate to add another student. Bridget Pederson announced that she would be resigning from the Call Committee to focus on her other church duties. She did come prepared with names of potential replacements. Those names were forwarded to Mary Jo for consideration by the Council, who are charged with appointments to the Call Committee.

We had discussions about candidates and the number of open positions appearing on the Synod web site. There are currently 34 open calls listed on the SW Minn Synod website. We ask that any Calvary member that knows of a pastor looking for a call fitting our position let our Call Committee know and we will get that information to the Synod. Final agenda item was a discussion about candidate questions. Dion Warne indicated he had some questions he uses in his interviews of potential bank employees and would provide them for our review.

CREATION CARE Pollinator Plot Update 1 February 2024 Edition


Did you know that Calvary has established a pollinator plot on the west portion of the former Bethesda property? Over 80 species of native plants were seeded and 2024 will be its second growing
