#### **PASTOR'S MESSAGE**

As we move into Holy Week, I am reminded of how Jesus' ministry was going to take a sudden change of direction and how this would affect the Disciples future ministries. Jesus' triumphed entry into Jerusalem to his arrest, death on the cross to his resurrection 3 days later. It reminds me of how a river flows and moves through a valley. The Scriptures are rich in this river language, the life-giving rivers that flow through the Garden of Eden, the Nile River that Moses was placed into that saved him. Lest we forget as we are in the Gospel of Mark this year, Jesus' ministry started with him being baptized in the Jordan River. Rivers are life giving. Growing

up in East Tennessee in a broad valley, the Holston River was the main feature that flowed through this valley. It was fed by hundreds of mountain streams and springs and the water from the springs is so cold and refreshing. Growing up around flowing water I learned quickly that a person can't drink from a water source that wasn't moving. Stagnate water is poisonous and will make a person very sick, it can't be used for irrigation as it would harm the plants that need the water. Life needs water to survive and the water must be moving water to be life giving water. The church is like water, when it is moving and flowing in its community it is life giving and it provides so much to its neighbors and we are living into Christ's calling to love our neighbor as ourselves. Unfortunately, sometimes a church becomes stagnated, maybe because of its struggling with some grief and loss, maybe it got complacent but once it stops flowing it can become stagnate and ceases to be life giving. Grief and loss need to be dealt with in a timely and compassionate manner, and if a church becomes complacent it is usually because it is looking backwards not forward. A church can't be a flowing river if it is looking backwards; when the church looks forward and starts moving it becomes the life-giving water God has intended for the church to be. I pray that we continue to look forward and when we do, we will the life-giving water to our neighbors in Willmar and move into our calling to love our neighbor as ourselves.

#### **Notice/Thank You**


