Ephesians 4 ¹⁴ We must no longer be children, tossed to and fro and blown about by every wind of doctrine by people's trickery, by their craftiness in deceitful scheming; ¹⁵ but speaking the truth in love, we must grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ, ¹⁶ from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by every ligament with which it is equipped, as each part is working properly, promotes the body's growth in building itself up in love.

The letter to the Ephesians is sending the church encouragement during a time of struggling. The members of the church were hearing many different concepts and doctrines that were causing division among the people. In this division and back biting the growth of the church was stunted. St. Paul was encouraging them to unite if faith. In verse 14 Paul tells them not to follow and chase after personalities, these personalities were deceiving members of the church, and this was causing division in the church. These personalities driven by a self-centered need for what they desired instead of putting Christ in the center by being deceitful and scheming to cause division. These personalities are in churches today, they purposely cause division in the church, and this can prevent the ministry of Christ from moving forward. Paul reminds us to be speaking the truth in love and grow into Christ. But how do we grow into Christ and not be deceived? Ephesians 4: 11 He himself granted that some are apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors and teachers ¹² to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ, ¹³ until all of us come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to maturity, to the measure of the full stature of Christ.

God sends us Christ centered people who can teach and prepare us for the ministry, these people are to prepare the saints and grow the people in the church so they can grow the church. No one comes to be a Christian already prepared to do the ministry, it takes teaching, preparing, support from the church leaders. We all have different a calling and varied ministries, and this is ties us together through Christ that makes the body of Christ with him as the head. This can't be accomplished in division, but it is accomplished in unity. We aren't always going to agree on everything but in love and grace we remain united to the cause of God's Kingdom. Let's take our God given talents and gifts out into the community and in doing this we can say "The church has left the building" and then we are doing Kingdom work. Pastor Dwaine Sutherland

Creation Care Tip

Reduce Paper Mail - Rather than receiving bills or bank statements in the mailbox, pay bills online and opt for email updates to save paper. Reduce paper by unsubscribing from junk mail or registering for electronic promotions and updates. To decide what types of mail you do and don't want from marketers, register at the Direct Marketing Association's (DMA) consumer website DMAchoice.org, and choose what catalogs, magazine offers, and other mail you want to get. DMAchoice will stop most, but not all, promotional mail. You'll have to pay a \$4 processing fee, and your registration will last for 10 years. If you do not have online access, register by sending your name and address (with signature), along with a \$5 processing fee (check or money order payable to the Association of National Advertisers or ANA) to:
