Dear Friends in Christ.

"...it is the God who said, 'Let light shine out of darkness,' who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ." (2 Cor. 4:6)

Ever so slowly and gradually God is turning up the light. Starting right around the annual winter solstice, the short winter days begin growing longer. How symbolic that Christmas is so close to the winter solstice. The increasing light of the sun reminds us of the light of God's Son. That was one of the themes of our Blue Christmas service held on December 18.

The season of Christmas will last now for 12 days, followed by the season of Epiphany. The season of Epiphany – from January 6 through March 2 – gives us time to reflect upon God shining into our hearts through Jesus. The stories that we will hear during the epiphany season will draw us again and again to the revealing of an identity. Who is this person born in Bethlehem? The Magi bring gifts of identity: gold for a king, frankincense for a priest, myrrh for the embalming of a body. At Jesus' baptism a light poured from heaven and a voice said, "You are my Son, my Beloved." At the wedding in Cana Jesus did the first of his signs and revealed his glory. Through the stories of Jesus' reading from the Isaiah scroll to the catch of fish at Galilee, to his transfiguration on the mountain – Jesus' identity is revealed.

When we live as people upon whom the light has shined, we are different. We are not like the sun, shining with its own heat and light – we are more like the moon, reflecting what shines on us. We are a mirror rather than a fire. We are reflections of God's love to our world.

As the Magi brought gifts to Jesus for the living out of his identity, so too are we given gifts for the living out of our lives as God's children. We Christians have a life to live, not just a message to tell; love to be acted out, not only explained; hope to be given, not merely kept privately for ourselves. Our ongoing task as Jesus' disciples is to share our gifts and to bring God's light and love to a world so much in need.
