Blessing for Father Figures




Do you know.....

A question on many people's minds these days is what's going to happen with visitation at Calvary now? The truth is- much of Calvary's visitation will go on as it has for a number of years!

We are blessed to have **THREE** visitation ministries at Calvary- did you know that? Many churches feel lucky to have only one visitation ministry!

Visitation at Calvary will continue to be provided once each month by the **Deaconess Ministry**. These volunteers take a flower to each of our shut

ins, care center residents, and those who request a visit. They share news of what's happening at church and remind folks that they are beloved by God- and by our congregation.

Once per month **Home Communion Ministry** volunteers come to the altar and receive the elements of Holy Communion that they take to our shut ins, care center residents, and those who request a visit. Sharing the love and promise of Jesus through the bread and wine, prayer and conversation are a gift for the volunteer as well as the recipient.

The **Befriender Ministry** is a lay-led, one-on-one listening ministry that stands ready to walk alongside anyone who is in need of a caring, faithful companion. Those experiencing loss, illness, or a major life transition may benefit from being paired with a Befriender minister.

Pastor Amy and Interim Pastor Rick will be visiting as needed- and as requested. We will meet regularly with these devoted ministry teams and will be kept up to date on the joys and challenges happening in the lives of those who receive their care.

THANK YOU to the volunteers who make these ministries successful. Calvary is blessed to have you all as part of our Outreach team.
