Each spring an extraordinary learning event takes place in Atlanta called The Orange Conference. "Orange" is an experience intended to "influence those who influence the faith and future of the next generation."

I attended an Orange Conference in 2017, when I was serving as the bishop of the Northwest Synod of Wisconsin. I'd heard about it, but I felt it was important enough to fly to Atlanta to



experience it. I was right. One of the prominent symbols of "Orange' is a jar of marbles. It contains one marble for each week of a child's life until the child turns 18. It is a visual reminder that every week of a child's life is precious, and God has put each of us in a place where we "can influence those who influence the faith and future of the next generation." Those marbles may represent the weeks in your own child's life... as well as those days when you feel you are losing your marbles. That child may be in your Sunday School classroom; in a home down the street; sitting in front of you in church; or walking across a stage to receive a high school diploma, with an empty jar sitting in their living room at home.

Calvary has a God-given opportunity this year to embrace that jar... and influence those kids, and those who influence the faith and future of those kids. As Pastor Amy, and those who work with her, embark on a new year created around a timeless message that mobilizes the next generation to love God and love people, walk with them... on Sundays, on Wednesdays and every other day of each week... of each marble... because every week of a child's life is precious and so are they.

Ten students and three chaperones ventured to Sioux Falls, SD for an overnight mission trip August 15 and 16. First stop? Five Guys Burgers and Fries for lunch! (Gotta get some energy (3)) Then on to Bishop Dudley Hospitality House where we played with children in residence there and gave a mom a muchneeded break. Friday afternoon/evening we had fun at The Butterfly House and Aquarium and at Wild Water West

waterpark before bunking at St. Mark's Lutheran Church where we shared pizza and a Bible Study before getting some sleep. Saturday morning we ate breakfast at IHOP and made our way to The Banquet homeless service ministry. We helped to serve lunch to over 200 people of all ages and we got the chance to eat lunch with them, too. After lunch and cleaning up we helped to distribute over 350 pre-filled backpacks to students in preschool through college. Before school starts, more than 7000 backpacks will be given away! It was awesome to share in the excitement of students receiving a new backpack with new school supplies ♥ We left the Banquet and headed to The Falls for a little time outdoors before loading up in the cars for the drive home. Thanks be to God and to the folks who donated so generously to make this Mission Trip happen. We were blessed by the opportunity to bless others. Our group unanimously decided that we're ready to go back to Sioux Falls again- and this time we're taking a bus so that many of YOU can come with us!

We exceeded our participation goal and the C.A.T. is dancing! 306 people completed the C.A.T survey and your input will be used to; 1) guide the Call Committee, when it is formed, in their mission to find Calvary's next Lead Pastor; 2) guide the leadership and the congregation in the years ahead as Calvary's mission is empowered through heritage but also through change.

Our Church Council, the Transition Team and key staff will be meeting with Rev. Kurt Jacobson, our C.A.T. Consultant, in the weeks ahead to learn how your input can teach us and lead us into God's future for Calvary.
