

#### FAITH FORMATION / SUNDAY SCHOOL & CONFIRMATION UPDATES & REMINDERS:

- \*\* Sunday School begins at 10:15 and ends at 11:15. There is coffee fellowship in the Friendship Room as well as a new COFFEE BAR in the Koinonia Room on the second floor of the Sunday School Wing. Parents are invited to stay and socialize, join in when Adult Forums are offered, check out the Library, or just relax!
- \*\* Students in grades 1-5 have Opening in the Sanctuary at 10:15- they can go to the Sanctuary before going to their classroom. Students in 3 year old, 4 year old, and Kindergarten classes can go to their classrooms to begin their day.
- \*\* Offering Envelopes were given to each student. We are going to receive Sunday School offering during music time in the Sanctuary. Students were told about why offerings are collected (to help others) and we plan to decide as a Sunday School where our offerings will be donated. Elissa Nelson is leading the group. We will meet in the Gathering Space from 10:15-11:15. Elissa will lead parents and children through a Bible Story and activities, songs, toys, and crafts that connect with the story of the day.
- \*\*THREE YEAR OLDS and THIRD GRADERS will receive Bibles during worship on Youth Sunday, October 5th. If you have a student who is older than 3 or older than 3th grade who has not received a Bible, please contact Pastor Amy or the church office and we will present a Bible to your student as well!


