



Dear Members and Friends of Calvary Lutheran,

This letter serves to inform you that I will be ending my Interim Pastor ministry with Calvary on November 14, 2025.

It has been my goal since beginning at Calvary in April to lead the congregation and leadership through the process of healing, self-awareness and through the Church Assessment Tool (C.A.T), setting goals and visions for the near and distant future and, along with these, being the best parish pastor that I could be for the wonderful people of Calvary.

I am so thankful to all of you for your warmth, your welcome and your patience with an old man, who truly loves being a pastor, but also loves the precious time he is given with his bride of almost 50 years.

And so, as Calvary and its leadership seek to discern the next steps, you will be served by a loving and gifted pastor, capable leaders and a sterling staff. I simply ask you to pray, to practice generosity and to be patient. You are in good hands, and the work you have done, and the learning from the C.A.T. will guide you into the future.
