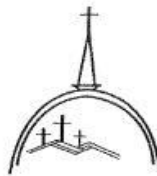

Dear Siblings in Christ at Calvary,

It is difficult to write this letter. In a perfect world, the work of the church would not be stifled because of financial or budgetary constraints. In a perfect world, all would have what they need and more. However, at this time in Calvary's history, our funds available for operating expenses do not meet our financial needs for operating expenses.

Last night, your Church Council had to make a very difficult fiscal decision to eliminate the position of Director of Music Ministry. Budgetary conversations and discussions regarding options for cutting expenses and prioritizing needs over wants have been ongoing for months. Your staff has done an amazing job of saving money and cutting back wherever possible. Your Board of Finance has worked diligently to ensure that bills have been paid on time and that the unexpected expenses of 2025 were addressed in the best ways possible.

The knowledge of these things does not make this announcement any more palatable, and it does not make the grief any less. There will be many questions that arise in the days to come. Please bring those questions to members of your Church Council. You may have constructive ideas regarding moving forward, please bring those ideas to your Church Council members. I'm sure there will be much discussion both inside and outside of the church building about yet another change at Calvary, but please remember that open, honest, constructive conversation with church leadership is more productive and promising than gossip, complaints or hearsay shared in cafes and coffee shops.

Hearts are grieving today. Naomi Powers Baker is a multi-talented and caring person. This decision in no way reflects on her personally or professionally. She has given so much of herself to Calvary. I thank her for sharing her talents and skills with so many, for teaching me personally about this congregation and the communities we serve, and for providing consistency through tumultuous times these past years. Thank you, Naomi.

An Elephant in the Garden, by Michael Morpurgo, is inspired by historical truths, and by his admiration for elephants. The family persuades the zoo director to let Marlene stay in their garden instead. When the city is bombed, the family flees with thousands of others, but how can they walk the same route when they have an elephant in tow, and keep themselves safe? Here is a story that brings together an unlikely group of survivors whose faith in kindness and love proves the best weapon of all.
