The Willmar CommUNITY Closet is a local nonprofit that provides free clothing and shoes to people and families. It is 100% donation-based and run by volunteers, meaning all items come from community members who donate clothing and volunteers help to sort, organize and distribute the items. We are a dedicated safe space where all are welcome, always.

What the CommUNITY Closet does:

Provides free clothing and footwear for people. Individuals and families can pick up clothes and shoes at no charge to help meet their basic needs.

We help reduce textile waste and support sustainability. By giving new life to donated items, it helps keep usable clothing out of landfills and extends the life of these resources.

We help build commUNITY support. The closet is a welcoming place that helps reduce clothing insecurity and foster a sense of support and inclusion in the community.

We are local. The closet operates in partnership with local groups including but not limited to Presbyterian Church, Bethel Church, Calvary Church, League of Women Voters, local youth groups, local group homes and so much more!
