PRM STAFF EXPECTATIONS AND POSITIONS

All Staff are required:

- To be at least 14 years old for Jr. Counselors and 16 years of age for Senior Counselor.
- To have a commitment to Christ, desire to serve Him and excited for the opportunity to share their faith.
- A genuine love for children and be able to place the needs and safety of the campers first and foremost at all times.
- Must seek to glorify God in the way that they live, present themselves, and interact with others.
- Limit the use of cell phones and other media devices to time off away from campers and activities going on.
- Abide by the policies and beliefs of Promise Ranch Ministries during their time at the Ranch. This includes clothing that is modest and appropriate for the occasion. Inappropriate language not permitted as it is not fitting for Christian witness and testimony. Smoking, drinking, and using drugs are not permitted on or off the grounds while serving on staff, for reasons of health, safety, and Christian witness. Anyone caught engaging in these activities is grounds for automatic dismissal.
- Must be patient, dependable, responsible, caring and have the ability to be flexible and go where help is needed.
- All summer counselors must complete 1 week of Staff Training before summer begins.
- Provide own transportation to and from Promise Ranch.
- Be on time for Staff Devotions.
- Seek own Support for this is a voluntary position.
- Able to communicate, any changes to your expected volunteer schedule.
- Bring own Lunch and water bottle.
- Summer Staff is requested to commit to a two week minimum service.

Application Process:

1. Complete and sign the written application form returning it to Promise Ranch.
2. Provide at least 3 references with a copy of the reference form asking that it be returned directly to Promise Ranch. (2 Non-family and 1 Pastoral)
3. Must obtain Clearances if 18 and over: Pennsylvania Child Abuse History Clearance, Pennsylvania State Police Criminal Record Check and Federal Bureau of Investigation Criminal Background Check. (See Page 9)
4. Include personal essay. (See page 7)
5. A personal interview at the director's discretion after reviewing application and references.
6. You will be notified of our decision.

Compensation Summer Missionary Opportunity

To qualify you must:

- Must be accepted to PRM Summer Staff (*excludes Jr. Counselors*)
- Must sign up and complete a minimum of 2 weeks of camp.
- We will provide you with a letter to mail out to your friends, family, and Church asking for support. Just like any missionary who may travel to another country to work, your compensation will come directly from the funds you raise. This is not a requirement but for our staff members that need to earn money during the summer. This is a way that PRM can assist you as we grow this ministry together.
- In the letter it will talk about what you will be doing, how long you have committed to serve and the amount we suggest for the position that you have requested. The money raised will come directly to PRM and put into an account for each individual Summer Missionary. At the end of the summer a stipend check will be sent to you, pending your completion of the time that you have committed to serve in your agreement. In the event that your contract is breached and you do not fulfill your obligation or you have been dismissed from PRM, all of the money raised will be forfeited to PRM and will be placed into a Scholarship fund.

Positions that Qualify for Summer Missionary Support

Camp Counselor: Minimum Age 16

Responsible for ensuring that camper's ages 5-18 have a fun and safe time, while sharing with them the love of Christ in both word and actions. Responsibilities include: upholding and enforcing rules of the camp to protect the health and safety of fellow staff members and campers, attend and sit with your campers at all meals and functions, complete required paperwork when needed, lead & teach devotions, assist in assigned daily activities, and ministering to the needs of others over physical, emotional, and spiritual needs over one's self.

Wrangler/Horse Barn Staff: Minimum age 16

We have a growing horse herd and are beginning to integrate equine activities into each week of the summer! You will work under the Head Wranglers and Horse Program Director spending most of your days at the barn, in the arena, or caring for our herd. The responsibilities can include but are not limited to: aiding in arena and ground lessons, doing work projects, helping with the daily upkeep and care of the facility, horse care, equipment care, ensuring the safety of campers before, during, and after all rides and equine events.

Media – Photographer/Videographer: Minimum age 16

Take pictures of every aspect of camp life, Attend and photograph all camp activities on a rotating basis, Edit and upload photos to website daily, Create a photo slide show for closing ceremony and a DVD families may purchase of each camp,

Activities Coordinator Assistant: Minimum age 16

Work one-on- one with the program director to design and run activities with the campers. You will be responsible for helping maintain and keep all craft supplies and activity equipment organized and notifying the Program Director of any items that need restocking including but not limited to craft time, team building, field games, and all other optional activities that campers may participate in. Be available for substitute counseling when needed.

Camp Nurse: Recommended – LPN / RN

If you are an adventurous LPN/RN who loves kids, this might be the job for you! The camp nurse is responsible for distributing daily medications, maintaining the health station and First Aid Kits, being on-call for emergencies, and taking care of common health needs that arise with camp life such as bee stings, bug bites, and scraped knees.

House Keeping :

Experience is helpful but not essential. Must be willing to be flexible, follow instructions, and work with other staff members. Assist with daily upkeep of the facility including but not limited to housekeeping, disinfecting surfaces, dusting, moping, and sweeping.

Grounds Keeping: (Must be 16 or over)

Some experience is required. Help us honor God by the way our property appears and is maintained. This includes cutting the grass, painting, weed pulling, tree trimming, road and trail maintenance, arena maintenance, including but not limited to construction or work projects that may arise.

3. If I am offered a position, I will, as a condition of my commitment be required to submit proof of my identity and legal right to work with children in the U.S.
4. I understand that; if I am offered a position, it will be offered on condition that my service shall be at will and be pursuant to Promise Ranch Ministries' Code of Conduct. I understand and agree that upon breach of this Code of Conduct by myself, I may be disciplined, up to and including termination of service.
5. I understand and agree that my commitment and service to Promise Ranch Ministries is at-will, and my service may be terminated by PRM at any time, with or without cause, and with or without notice, at the option of Promise Ranch Ministries.
6. I authorize Promise Ranch Ministries to verify all information provided. I authorize all former employers, persons, schools, companies, and law enforcement authorities to release any information concerning my background, and hereby release any said persons, schools, companies, and law enforcement authorities from liability for any damages whatsoever for issuing this information.

Act 34 Pennsylvania Criminal History Clearance

The Pennsylvania State Police has established a web-based computer application called "Pennsylvania Access to Criminal History" or PATCH. Using this system, a requestor can apply for a criminal background check on an individual. Eighty percent of the time, "No Record" certificates are returned immediately through the Internet to the requestor (you).

Go to "New Record" and follow the instructions.

The reason for the clearance is Volunteer.

VOLUNTEER clearances will not be accepted for employment purposes. (volunteer clearances are accepted by Promise Ranch and should be free to obtain)

When the Search Results Table appears, click on the Control Number. (Hint: Write down the Control Number for future access to you Official Clearance.)

The Records Check Details page will open, but this is not the official clearance and it will not be accepted by the PRM.

To access your Official Clearance you will see a blue text "CERTIFICATION PAGE". Click on the blue text to access your Act 34 Pennsylvania State Police Clearance.

Print and save the official clearance for your records and submit a copy to the Ranch Office

You will also be required to obtain your FBI Clearance. You can obtain thru "Identi-go" they have offices in Newport and Selinsgrove.

Anyone over 18 is also required to obtain their MANDATED REPORTER CERTIFICATE. This is also free to Acquire and just, good to have. Keepsafekids.com to process.
