NEW FIELDS ADDED TO PATIENT DEMOGRAPHIC INSURANCE TAB NEW MEDICARE BENEFICIARY IDENTIFIER MBI

There was recently an upgrade to your Lytec Practice Management Software to accommodate the **NEW Medicare Beneficiary Identifier MBI**

If the new MBI # is not available, when the old Medicare # is entered in to this field it will turn yellow with a message that reads: "Not a valid MBI". This is ok for the old Medicare #.

When the new MBI # is available, the old Medicare # should be moved to the Legacy Medicare ID field and the new Medicare MBI # entered in to the Insured ID Number/MBI field. If the MBI # is entered in the correct format, it will appear green and noted as a "Valid MBI". If the MBI # is entered in the incorrect format, it will remain yellow and noted as "Not a valid MBI".
