

**Georgia Institute of Technology Cael Cernich 2019 game worn jersey, size large.**

Grayson, Georgia native Cael Cernich is an Industrial Engineering major. Cernich began playing roller hockey at age 5, making the transition to ice hockey later. Before coming to Tech, Cernich played on the Atlanta Phoenix Bantam Majors, a travel ice hockey team that brought home the winning trophy from the USA Hockey Championships in April 2013. In his third season with the Yellow Jackets, he led all defensemen in points during the 2018-19 season with 15 in 23 games played. He was named to the 2018-19 ACHA Third Team All-South Region. These Rebirth Sports special edition jerseys with a lace up neckline were worn by the Jackets for two games during the 2019 Savannah Hockey Classic. The front of the jersey has the Georgia Tech Ramblin' Wreck, along with the ACHA and Rebirth logos, all printed on the gold material. An embroidered tournament patch is sewn to the front next to the ACHA logo. Two color numbers and striping are also printed, as is the gold GEORGIA TECH letters running down the left sleeve. On the right shoulder is a printed yellow jacket logo. The Rebirth logo is printed at the rear hemline and their wordmark logo is printed on the back below the neckline. A fight strap is sewn onto the back. The jersey was designed to be similar to the blue alternate jerseys worn by the Atlanta Thrashers beginning in 2003. Tech defeated the University of Georgia to win the tourney's Thrasher Cup. I purchased this jersey directly from the team.
