

Macon Mayhem Zach Urban 2018-19 game worn jersey, size 54.

Kelowna, British Columbia native Zach Urban played 176 games in the British Columbia Hockey League (BCHL) from 2010 through 2014, tallying 12 goals, 54 assists and 66 points. The 6-3, 205-pound defenseman then played two seasons at Northern Michigan University alongside Mayhem teammate John Siemer from 2014 through 2016, recording one goal and six assists in 43 games. Urban came to the Macon Mayhem in 2017 after taking a year off from hockey. Urban played 36 regular season and six playoff games, scoring one goal with 17 assists. During his second professional season, Urban was loaned to the ECHL Toledo Walleye for ten games but returned to play 40 games for the Mayhem. The front of this white jersey manufactured by OT Sports has the embroidered primary logo sewn on the front. A small OT logo is screened onto the fabric in the neckline. On each shoulder are sewn on embroidered secondary logo patches. The numbers are sewn-on two color twill. The contrasting fabric nameplate has sewn on single color twill letters. Embroidered SPHL and OT Sports patches are sewn on at the bottom of the rear hemline. There is good game wear on the sleeves. I purchased this jersey directly from the player at the conclusion of the season.
