

Atlanta Gladiators Kevin Montgomery 2018-19 game worn jersey, size 56.

Rochester, New York native Kevin Montgomery was drafted in the fourth round, 110th overall, by the Colorado Avalanche in the 2006 NHL Entry Draft. Prior to playing professionally, he spent one year with Ohio State University and then three seasons with the London Knights of the Ontario Hockey League, with call-ups to the AHL Lake Erie Monsters in the '07-08 and '08-09 seasons. Montgomery played two full seasons in the AHL before pursuing opportunities across Europe in Denmark, Slovakia, Italy and Austria. The Gladiators are the second ECHL team that Montgomery has been a part of. In 2015-16, Montgomery played 35 games with the Florida Everblades, scoring four goals with 13 assists. This gold CCM jersey represents the first major redesign to the Gladiators jerseys in 15 seasons. It has the embroidered Gladiators primary logo sewn on the front, along with Montgomery's alternate captain A and a slightly redesigned embroidered Kroger sponsor patch. Two alternate logo patches sewn onto each shoulder and the matching fabric player nameplate has single color sewn twill letters on the back. The player numbers are sewn two color twill. Embroidered CCM logos are sewn below the neckline in front and back. An embroidered ECHL logo is sewn on at the center of the rear hemline. This jersey was purchased directly from the team.
