Timmons, Ottawa native Steve Zoryk, who is of Ukrainian descent, played for the Trax for two seasons from 2003-2005. Zoryk's two seasons in Macon were the most productive of his professional career, scoring 69 goals with 76 assists in 111 regular season games. When the team folded following the 2004-05 season, Zoryk followed coach Tommy Stewart to Florida, where he played his last two seasons of professional hockey with the Florida Seals and Jacksonville Barracudas before retiring. This black OT Sports jersey shows nice game wear which includes holes in the sleeve area and stick marks and pilling on the front. The embroidered primary team logo is sewn on the front and the shoulders have a pair of embroidered secondary logos. The numbers are sewn two color twill.
