

Augusta Lynx Jim Baxter 2001-02 game worn jersey, size 58.

Brantford, Ontario native Jim Baxter played three years of junior hockey with the Oshawa Generals before turning pro in the 1999-00 season in the ECHL. He was drafted in the seventh round of both the 1997 and 1999 NHL Entry Drafts. Baxter split his first pro season between Dayton and Tallahassee, spending the entire 2000-01 season with Tallahassee. He began the 2001-02 season with Augusta but was dealt to the Mississippi Sea Wolves on December 11, 2001 in exchange for Jeff Bes. It was with the Sea Wolves that Baxter had his best years, including being named the 2002-03 CCM Defenseman of the Year in the ECHL. This white with black and silver trim CCM jersey sports the embroidered five color Lynx head crest on the front and a pair of embroidered Lynx paw and puck patches on each shoulder. The numbers consist of three color sewn twill, and the matching cloth nameplate has three color sewn twill letters. Embroidered CCM logos are located on the lower left front hem and on the back below the neckline. The embroidered CINTAS sponsor patch is sewn on the upper right chest. Baxter's autograph in black Sharpie is just to the left of the sewn on embroidered American flag patch that was added following the 9/11 attacks. The jersey shows good game use consisting of stick marks, tears and board burns. I acquired this jersey from an eBay auction.
