

**Columbus Cottonmouths Vadim Guskov 2016-17 game worn jersey, size 54.**

Kazan, Russia native Vadim Guskov was drafted in the second round of the 2009 Canadian Hockey League import draft by the Guelph Storm. After playing one season for the Storm, Guskov returned to Russia for four seasons before returning to the states. While with the Berkshire Battalion in 2014-15, he was selected by Federal Hockey League as the inaugural recipient of the FHL Man of the Year Award for his off-the-ice community involvement. Guskov spent the 2015-16 season with the Macon Mayhem and split the 2016-17 season between Macon and Columbus. The front of this white Bauer jersey has an embroidered sewn on snake head logo and the back and sleeves have sewn on three color numbers that have two of the colors screened on the bottom twill layer. On the shoulders are two sewn on embroidered wordmark logo patches. On the back is a sewn on cloth nameplate with the player's name in single color heat pressed twill. The Cottonmouths name and Bauer logos on the lower back are printed, as is the Bauer logo on the front chest and the printing on the collar. The embroidered Sunshine Banners sponsor patch is sewn on but the others are screen printed on twill and sewn on. This jersey has been photo matched to a photo taken during a playoff game on April 12, 2017, the last time these white jerseys were worn. It was purchased from a fan who acquired it at a team auction at the conclusion of the Cottonmouths's last season.
