Lindsy, Ontario native Matt Ginn played four years of NCAA Div. 1 for the College of the Holy Cross, Worcester Massachusetts. Ginn set numerous school records including 7760 playing minutes, 8 shutouts, .917 career save percentage and 3587 career saves, registering over 1000 saves in the 2013-14 season alone. Following graduation, he was offered an amateur tryout contract with the Florida Everblades, where he posted a 5-1-1 record with a 2.12 GAA. Ginn signed with the Bruins in 2015 and was assigned to the Gladiators, where he played for three seasons. In his final season in Atlanta, he found himself third in line behind Bruins' prospects Dan Vladar and Sean Bonar, appearing in only six games. He spent the next two seasons in Europe with the Manchester Storm. These black Athletic Knit specialty jerseys were designed for the fan favorite Star Wars Night and were worn on February 18, 2017. The primary logo is sublimated onto black twill and sewn on the front. The embroidered Kroger sponsor patch is sewn on the right front. Everything else is sublimated to the jersey, including the Mandalorian crest, the Slave Ship and Boba Fett's likeness on the sleeves. Atlanta Gladiators is spelled out on the front and back hemline in the Mandalorian alphabet. Ginn's autograph is in black Sharpie on the rear number. Since Ginn was the backup goalie for Dan Vladar, who played the entire game, this jersey is listed as game issued. The jerseys were auctioned off after the game and I acquired this jersey from the original owner.
