

Columbus Cottonmouths Will Barlow 2007-08 game worn jersey, size 56.

Oakville, Ontario native Will Barlow turned pro with the Cottonmouths after four years of NCAA Division 3 college hockey at the State University of New York at Fredonia. In his five seasons with the Snakes, the 5'9" 180 lb. defenseman appeared in 254 regular season games, scoring seven goals with 45 assists for 52 points. Barlow also racked up 424 minutes in penalties. He became the fifth team captain in the Snakes history at the start of the 2010-11 season, leading the team to a President's Cup in his last pro season in 2011-12. He pursued a career as a financial advisor following his retirement. This black Athletic Knit jersey from Barlow's first professional season has the classic embroidered snake head logo sewn on the front, along with a sublimated Jay Auto Mall sponsor patch and the AK logo. The snake numbers on the back and sleeves are two color sewn twill. The nameplate is black twill with single color sewn twill letters. On the left shoulder is a sewn on embroidered United States Army Infantry School insignia patch, a tribute to the school that is located at nearby Fort Benning. Embroidered SPHL and AK patches are sewn on the back hemline. Barlow's autograph in black Sharpie is on the back number. The jersey exhibits great game wear and team repairs.
