

Atlanta Gladiators Matt Ginn 2015-16 game used goalie stick.

Lindsay, Ontario native Matt Ginn attracted the attention of the Boston Bruins while he played four years at the College of the Holy Cross, Worcester Massachusetts. Ginn set numerous school records including 7760 playing minutes, 8 shutouts, .917 career save percentage and 3587 career saves, registering over 1000 saves in the 2013-14 season alone. Following graduation, he was offered an amateur tryout contract with the Florida Everblades, where he posted a 5-1-1 record with a 2.12 GAA. The next season, Ginn signed with the Bruins and was assigned to the Gladiators, where he played for three seasons. In his final season in Atlanta, he found himself third in line behind Bruins' prospects Dan Vladar and Sean Bonar, appearing in only six games. He spent the next two seasons in Europe with the Manchester Storm. This Warrior goalie stick shows extensive use based on the sheer number of puck marks on the blade alone. There is a crack across the paddle Ginn's autograph is in black Sharpie on the paddle. I acquired this stick from the original owner, who obtained it directly from the player.
