

Columbus Cottonmouths Kiel Wilgosh 2005 game worn jersey, size XXL.

Winnipeg, Manitoba native Kiel Wilgosh played junior hockey for three seasons with the Opaskwayak Cree Nation Blizzard before he was signed by the Cottonmouths at the start of the 2005-06 season. Wilgosh only played three professional games, his last one being a road game at Jacksonville against the Barracudas. It was at this game that the teams wore football themed jerseys on the eve of the Georgia-Florida football game played in Jacksonville. The Snakes represented the University of Georgia and the Barracudas showed their support for the University of Florida. This Athletic Knit white jersey with red and black trim has the GEORGIA team name in sewn two color twill across the front. The numbers are sewn single color twill. Embroidered snake head logo patches are sewn on each shoulder. There is no nameplate. The body of the jersey is comprised of a lightweight fabric, pretty typical for specialty jerseys, but does have reinforced shoulders, elbows and a fight strap. On the rear hemline is an embroidered AK patch, which has been sewn on over top of the round heat-pressed AK logo typically found on lower quality jerseys. I acquired this jersey from another collector.
