2022-23 was Woodstock, Georgia native Zach Yoder's second full season with the Gladiators. After leaving Georgia to play junior hockey up north, followed by one year at the Air Force Academy and three seasons with Ferris State University, Yoder longed to play closer to home. After signing an amateur tryout contract with Toledo in 2020, his dream of playing professional hockey was halted by the COVID pandemic. In July of 2021, he was signed by the Gladiators. A true stay-at-home defenseman, Yoder netted his first professional goal on November 29 in a 5-1 loss to the Ghost Pirates at home. He added two more over the course of the season, both at Jacksonville against the Icemen. This blue and gold Athletic Knit road jersey has the embroidered alternate logo sewn on the front. Two sponsor patches, made up of sublimated graphics on white twill, are sewn on the front and back. An embroidered primary logo patch is sewn on the right shoulder. Single color twill letters make up the sewn on matching fabric nameplate and two color twill numbers are sewn on the back and right sleeve. Reminiscent of the Thrashers design, two color letters spelling out Gladiators are found running down the left sleeve. Embroidered AK patches are sewn below the front and rear necklines and the embroidered ECHL patch adorns the lower rear hemline. The jersey has some moderate wear and team repairs and has been photo matched to a game photo taken April 7 using a defect on the lower left sleeve. I acquired the jersey directly from the player.
