Max Milosek was signed to a three-game tryout at the conclusion of the 2017-18 season after completing his last year at the University of Wisconsin-Stevenson Point. The Lapeer, Michigan native posted a 17-6-3 record and a 1.87 GAA and .925 save percentage in 26 games in his last season. Over his four seasons of NCAA Division III hockey, Milosek went 54-15-8 with a 2.10 GAA and .914 SV% in 78 games played. Milosek was the starting goaltender for the 2015-2016 team that won the NCAA Division III National Championship. He posted a 19-4-2 record, 2.00 GAA and .917 SV% in 25 games that season, and he allowed just one goal on 21 shots in the team's 5-1 win over St. Norbert College in the 2016 NCAA Division III National Championship Game. Prior to his collegiate career, Milosek played four seasons in the North American Hockey League, going 64-41-10 with a 2.57 GAA and .917 SV%. This white jersey by OT Sports was worn by Milosek as a backup goaltender. The embroidered primary logo is sewn on the front. A smaller secondary logo is screened onto the fabric in the neckline. On each shoulder are sewn on embroidered patches commemorating the Mayhem's championship season in 2016-17. The numbers are sewn on two color twill. Below the rear neckline is a screened on outline of the state of Georgia. The matching fabric nameplate has sewn on twill letters. There is evidence of a nameplate change. Troy Passingham wore the same number earlier in the season and the wear is consistent with greater use. The embroidered SPHL and OT Sports patches are sewn on at the bottom of the rear hemline. I acquired this jersey directly from the team. In 2023, the jersey was sold to a fan who collects Max Milosek jerseys.
