This set 2 Reebok Edge 2.0 gamer served as the road jersey for the Thrashers. It has the embroidered Thrashers logo sewn on the front, two alternate logo patches sewn onto each shoulder and the sewn player nameplate with two color twill letters on the back. Player numbers, in two color sewn twill are located on the back and on both sleeves. The neckline also has the embroidered NHL shield and the row of yellow arrows that were moved from their previous location on the bottom tail of the jersey in 2007. Hedberg was, in my opinion, the most consistent goaltender the Thrashers had during their eleven seasons. This jersey shows numerous puck marks, team repairs and pilling. This jersey has been photo matched to photos of Hedberg taken in January, 2010, and is complete with a letter of authenticity from the Atlanta Thrashers and Meigray. I purchased it from another collector.
