

**Atlanta Fire Ants Corey Belitski 1994 game worn jersey, size 56.**

Calgary native Corey Belitski turned pro during Atlanta's one and only Roller Hockey International (RHI) season in 1994 during the summer after the Atlanta Knights won the International Hockey League championship. Belitski played junior and college hockey in Canada before his fifteen games in the IHL, scoring four goals with seventeen assists. This white mesh CCM home jersey with black, red and yellow colors has the primary logo and flames printed on the fabric. The elbows and shoulders have reinforced fabric. The numbers are sewn on two color twill and the matching fabric nameplate has sewn on two color twill letters. The fonts used for the numbers and letters are virtually the same as those on the Atlanta Knights jerseys. The embroidered Conley Buick sponsor patch is sewn on the right shoulder. The embroidered CCM Roller Hockey International patch is sewn on at the bottom of the rear hemline. There is some good game wear visible. Atlanta IHL jerseys worn by the players are hard to find and the museum feels privileged to have one. I acquired this jersey from another collector.
