

Atlanta Flames Hilliard Graves 1974-75 game worn jersey, size 46.

Right-winger Hilliard Graves scored 27 goals in his first full NHL season with the California Seals but after a sub-par sophomore season he was traded to the Atlanta Flames for John Stewart. Both Stewart and Graves wore the same number while in Atlanta so it is possible that this could be a recycled Stewart jersey. The numbers are attached with only single color thread, which according to a noted collector of Atlanta Flames jerseys, puts this as a '74-75 jersey. Graves spent two and a half seasons in Atlanta as a versatile forward and was traded to the Vancouver Canucks in December, 1976. This white home durable game jersey has a two color sewn twill logo on the front, along with two color sewn twill numbers on the sleeves and back. A garter style fight strap with the metal clip missing is sewn inside the lower back. An embroidered Rawlings neck tag is sewn on and bears the size. There are numerous stick marks and team repairs. This jersey was acquired from another collector.
