

**Atlanta Knights Grant Jennings 1995-96 game worn jersey, size 52.**

Saskatchewan native Grant Jennings played in 389 regular season NHL games and 54 Stanley Cup playoff games, winning back to back Stanley Cups with the Pittsburgh Penguins in 1991 and 92. Jennings joined the Knights late in the '95-96 season and played in three regular season games and three playoff games for Atlanta. The 6'3" 210 pounder racked up 39 penalty minutes over the six games. Jennings stayed with the team when they relocated to Quebec as the Rafales in '96-97 and ended his professional career at the end of the '97-98 season in San Antonio with the IHL Dragons. This white Bauer road jersey has the Knights embroidered sewn on logo of the front, sewn two color twill numbers on the back and sleeves, and a matching nameplate with sewn two color twill letters. Bauer and IHL logos are embroidered directly to the jersey the right rear hem line. The IHL logo letters are embroidered over white twill for the last season jerseys only. There are several stick marks and other light wear evident on this jersey. I purchased this jersey from another collector.
