

**Macon Whoopees Steve Suk 1998-99 Turn Back The Clock commemorative game worn jersey, size XXL.**

This white mesh jersey has the original Macon Whoopees logo from the 1973-74 season on the front and the original 1973 style embroidered jersey patches on each shoulder. The sewn number #20 on the back and the sleeves, as well as the sewn nameplate is in blue twill. There is a screened Jersey Express logo and an embroidered Contak Hockey logo on the back hem, along with a fight strap. According to the original owner, the jersey was obtained from Steve Suk and he autographed it across the top of the number on the back. The seams at the bottom of each side were reportedly cut by Suk so the jersey would not be so tight around the hip. This jersey is also signed by former 1973 team members Brian Tapp, Bob Dupuis, Bill Buckley, along with bus driver Roger Gibson. It's also signed by Ed Grisamore, who co-authored the book about the original Macon Whoopees with Bill Buckley. The jersey was worn during a game between Macon and the Fort Worth Fire on February 6, 1999. It was purchased from an eBay auction.
