

Augusta Lynx Brent Gauvreau 2002-03 game worn jersey, size 58.

Brent Gauvreau's eleven year pro career has literally taken him all over the world, playing for many years in several countries in Europe. Appearing in only 18 games for the Lynx in 2002-03 before being dealt to the Jackson Bandits for their final season in the ECHL, Gauvreau netted only four goals and three assists, with a dismal -22 plus/minus rating. This white set 1 jersey from OT Sports is very similar to the CCM jerseys that the team used in their previous three seasons. It has the embroidered lynx head patch sewn on the front with the alternate paw and puck logo patches sewn on each shoulder. On the back, the restored white cloth nameplate has sewn two color letters, and the numbers consists of three color sewn twill. The lower right hem has the old style embroidered East Coast Hockey League patch, the last season it would be used prior to the name change to ECHL. Also on the back hem are the Meigray and OT Sports patches. The sleeve numbers are also sewn three color twill and the CINTAS sponsor patch is sewn on the upper right front. There are stick marks on the front and back and the bottom of the neckline is torn. This jersey was purchased directly from Meigray.
