

Atlanta Thrashers Marty Reasoner 2008-09 game worn jersey, size 56.

Marty Reasoner played for six different NHL teams during his professional career. The upstate New York native came to the Thrashers for two seasons beginning in 2008. This set 2 Reebok Edge 2.0 third jersey was first introduced for the 2008-09 season and was met with mostly bad reviews. The decision to introduce a radical new home jersey design was even more questionable when you consider the team spent considerable money to brand Philips Arena as Blueland over several seasons while wearing their blue home jerseys and perhaps further confirms the bad management decisions that ultimately led to the team's demise. This jersey was only worn for seven dates and has light wear. The front has the Thrashers wordmark logo in an arched pattern across the chest, with the player number in two color sewn twill below that. Sleeve and back numbers are also sewn two color twill. Reasoner's autograph is written on the number nine with a black Sharpie. An embroidered Reebok logo patch is sewn on the upper back just below the neckline and above the matching fabric nameplate with two color sewn letters. On each shoulder are a pair of Thrashers alternate logo patches. The NHL shield logo patch is sewn to the neckline. I acquired this jersey from another collector.
